
Awareness of the facts surrounding bladder cancer can help you be informed and diligent about your bladder health.




The rate of bladder cancer diagnosis has been on the decline since 2010. Bladder cancer deaths are also on the decline.



Bladder cancer is more common in men, ranking as the 4th most common cancer among the male population.



About ½ of diagnosed bladder cancers are found when the cancer is still within the inner layer of the bladder wall.



Bladder cancer predominantly occurs in people over the age of 55, with 73-yearsold as the average age at diagnosis.



Smoking (including cigarettes, cigars, and pipes) is thought to cause nearly ½ of all bladder cancers.
