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SUTAB Instructions

The Dosing Regimen

 It is a split-dose (2-day) regimen. There are a total of 24 tablets that are required in order to complete bowel preparation for the colonoscopy. You will take the tablets in two doses of 12 tablets each. You <u>must</u> consume water with each dose.

How to Take Each Dose (completed the exact same way for each dose at the times listed on your procedure instructions)

- Fill the cup that is provided for you with water to the 16 ounce line.
- As you take each tablet, allow yourself 2 minutes in between so that you do not become nauseous. You should complete taking all 12 tablets within 30 minutes.
 - Should you start feeling nauseated, please slow down the rate of water consumption as we do not want you to throw any of the medication up.
 - <u>Do not</u> take multiple tablets at one time.
- 1 hour after you take the last tablet, you will need to fill your cup back up with water to 16 ounces drink it entirely.
- 30 minutes after finishing the second container of water, you will need to fill your cup back up with water to 16 ounces drink it entirely.

Important Notes to Note

- You should only follow a clear liquid diet the day before your procedure.
- You <u>should not</u> consume any food or liquid, aside from the bowel prep, the morning of your procedure - *DO NOT LISTEN TO THE BOX*.
- Everyone has different reaction times to the medication, therefore we do not have an exact time as to when the medication will start working.
- The most common adverse reactions after administration of SUTAB were nausea, abdominal distension (bloating), vomiting, and upper abdominal pain.
- Please stay as hydrated as possible. Should you start to feel severely dehydrated, contact our office.
- Please call 911 or go to the nearest emergency room should you start experiencing cardiac arrhythmias or seizures.
