Can I have my baby at Piedmont Newnan Hospital?

Beginning Jan 8th, our providers will no longer be providing care at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. We recommend you go to Piedmont Fayette Hospital. If you decide to go to Piedmont Newnan Hospital, then your baby will be delivered by a provider not associated with Southern Crescent Women's Healthcare.

If I deliver at Piedmont Newnan Hospital, can I still have my postpartum visit with your practice?

Yes, we will take care of for your 6 to 8-week postpartum visit.

Where will I have my surgery?

All surgeries will be performed at Piedmont Fayette Hospital by your doctor starting Jan 8, 2024.

Can I get my mammogram, lab work, CT scan etc. at Piedmont Newnan Hospital?

Yes, you can go to Piedmont Newnan Hospital to have your mammogram, lab work or CT scan. They will send your report to our office.

What if I am experiencing an OB or Gyn emergency, can I go to the emergency room at Piedmont Newnan Hospital?

If you have a life threatening emergency call 911 otherwise, we are available 24 hours a day to assist your concerns with the answering service. If you do choose Piedmont Newnan we will not be available to take care of you but we can see you in a follow up appointment.

Why is Southern Crescent Women's Healthcare no longer providing care at Piedmont Newnan Hospital?
