Picky Eater or Selective Eater?

Causes

There is no real know "cause" of Selective Eating. Environmental influences, Reflux, Prematurity, Sensory Integration Disorders, Anxiety disorders and negative feeding experiences can increase the incidence.

Can reduce the risk of medical or developmental complications and social and emotional issues.

Selective Eating can lead to medical, nutritional, social and emotional difficulties for the child and it can negatively impact family life.



That sounds like my child, what should I do?

The "just make him eat" or "he will eat when he gets hungry" strategies do not work with Selective Eaters and may actually make things worse.

Until I get feeding therapy, what can I do at home?

- Have family meals
- Continue to offer unstressed presentations of non-favored foods
- Do not bribe, sneak or force any food
- Ignore or time-out undesired behaviors

Gagging, coughing, choking

Common Characteristics

- Extreme food selectivity
- Refuses unfamiliar foods
- Fear of food or food anxiety
- Rigid eating habits
- Limited variety (<20 foods)
- Strong negative reaction to the introduction of new foods
- Oral sensory and motor issues
- Does not eat family diet
- Disruptive mealtime behaviors
- Food jags

Complications

- Poor nutrition
- Social and emotional anxiety
- Developmental delays




